WHEREAS, The present accommodations at the State Cattle Scales are inadequate to the proper dispatch and requirements of the business now being done, therefore

Be it resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorized to appoint a committee consisting of two competent persons whose duty it shall be to examine the property, condition of scales, fencing, &c., &c., and report to the Governor what additional accommodations are needed at said scales, together with the estimate of the cost of the same, and upon the receipt of the said report the Governor shall transmit the same to the General Assembly, with such recommendations as in his judgment the interest of the State demand.
