Appropriat'n therefor.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the sum of three thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying the expenses incurred by the commissioners in the execution of the said Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, and such compensation to said commissioners as the Governor shall deem reasonable, for their services under said Act, and also for the pur-

Compensat'n pose of paying like compensation to the said commissioners for services to be rendered under the authority conferred by this Act, and the expenses to be incurred in its execution; and the Comptroller is hereby directed to issue his warrant or warrants upon the Treasurer in pursuance of the Governor's order therefor, in payment of such sums of money as may be hereby required.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That all Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with this Act, be and they are hereby repealed; and this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 211.
