CHAP. CCLXIX.

A Supplement to the act, entitled, An act to Incorporate a Company to open the navigation of Zuchia Run. Lib. TH. No. 5, fol. 442.* Passed Feb 5, 1817
* 1811, ch. 191

WHEREAS, several of the persons named as commissioners in the act to which this is a supplement, have died and removed from Charles county, before the commencement of the operations authorised by the said act, and it being found inconvenient to procure the attendance of a majority of the commissioners for the purposes designated therein, and it being also discovered that the sum to be raised by lottery would be insufficient for the object intended to be effected thereby; to remedy which, Preamble

1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That William Penn, Edward Edelin, Joseph Barker, Raphael Boarman, be appointed in the place of Jesse Jameson, Smith Hardkin, and Joseph Simpson, deceased, and of John B. Morris removed, and that any five of the whole number of the commissioners shall have full power and authority to do and perform all matters and things which might or could be done by the whole of the said commissioners, or a majority of them, and that upon the death, resignation, or removal out of Charles county, of any one of the commissioners aforesaid, or upon his declining to act, those managers who shall undertake to discharge the several duties to them assigned, or any five of them, shall have the power to fill all such vacancies as shall from time to time arise in manner aforesaid, until the duties shall be performed. Additional commissioners appointed

2. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the sum to be raised by the scheme of a lottery mentioned in the said act, shall be extended to fifty thousand dollars, and it shall be lawful for the said corporation to sell or dispose of the said tickets or scheme of the lottery aforesaid, within the city and precincts of Baltimore, or elsewhere. 3. AND BE IT ENACTED. That the said commissioners, or any five of them, shall have power to appoint the periods and places necessary for receiving subscriptions under the act to which this is a supplement. Subscriptions

CHAP. CCLXX.

An Act to lay out and make public a Road in Dorchester County. Lib. TH. No. 5, fol. 443. Passed Feb 3, 1817

1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Doctor Clement Stanford, Doctor William Jackson, and William Sherman, be and they are hereby authorised and required to survey, lay out and open, a road not exceeding thirty feet in width, from Chickone gate, in Dorchester county, through the Indian-Town, down to the Walnut Landing, in the said county; *Provided* that the said road shall not pass through the buildings, yards, gardens or orchards, of any person or persons, without the consent of the owner or owners thereof. 2. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the commissioners aforesaid shall cause a plot and certificate of the said road so surveyed, laid out and opened, to be lodged in the office of the clerk of Dorchester county, on or before the first Monday in June next, to be laid be- Plot and certificate to be lodged in clerk's office
