THE FOLLOWING LAWS WERE ENACTED, TO WIT:

1802.

CHAPTER 1.

CHAP. 1.

- An Act relative to the continuance of Causes in the Court of Appeals, and to alter the time of holding the same. Lib. JG. No. 4, fol. Passed Jan. 8, 1803 207.
- 1. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Court may continue causes. the court of appeals, now sitting, be and they are hereby authorised to continue any cause depending in the said court until and during the November term, eighteen hundred and two, which they may in their discretion think proper, in order for a hearing on the merits, and not for delay.
- 2. AND HE IT ENACTED, That no action pending, or which may No action to continue longer than hereafter be instituted, in the court of appeals, shall continue lon-endoffourth court ger than the end of the fourth court after the same shall have been instituted, unless by consent of parties, at the discretion of the court.

3. This section fixed the times for holding the court of appeals, which have since been altered by 1805, ch. 65, s. 7, and other acts.

An Act to settle and ascertain the Salary of Members of the Council Passed Jan. 8, 1803 for the ensuing year. Lib. JG. No. 4, fol. 207.

BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Salary ascertained each member of the council shall be entitled to receive, for the ensuing year, the sum of two hundred pounds current money for his salary.

CHAP. III,

An Act for the relief of John Erskine, of Talbot County. Lib. JG. Passed Jan. 8, 1803. No. 4, fol. 208. See note under 1800, ch. 44.

CHAP. IV.

An Act to authorise and empower the Justices of the Levy Court of Passed Jan. 8, 1803 Charles County to levy a sum of money for the purpose of repairing the Poor-House in said County. Lib. JG. No. 4, fol. 208.

WHEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, that the Preamble. poor-house of Charles county is in a situation that requires immediate repair,
