Proceedings of Election of President and Vice President of the United States of America in and for the State of Maryland.

It was on Wednesday January 27th 1857 the Electors of the State of Maryland for President and Vice President of the United States assembled in the State House at Annapolis. There were present: James B. Todd, William P. Miller, Charles B. Butler, William B. Todd, Augustus Stephen, William H. Bland and Thomas P. Kitchin. James B. Todd's name had been declared by the Electors and Thomas P. Kitchin's name had been declared by the Electors.

Robert S. Fort of the Governor, Maryland was duly elected to fill the vacancy caused by the absence of James O. Fort, and took his place with the Electors.

The following certificate is deposited in the State of Maryland from Governor Robert S. Fort, Governor of the State of Maryland, to the Electors of the State of Maryland, to wit: James O. Fort, Charles B. Butler, Augustus Stephen, William H. Bland, and Thomas P. Kitchin.

The Government of the State of Maryland, in accordance with the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of Maryland, passed on the 29th day of March 1857, and amended by subsequent acts, do hereby certify to the Electors of the State of Maryland, to wit: James O. Fort, Charles B. Butler, Augustus Stephen, William H. Bland, and Thomas P. Kitchin, that the said act of the Legislature of the State of Maryland, passed on the 29th day of March 1857, and amended by subsequent acts, is in full force and effect in the State of Maryland.
