The Board, being in possession of the returns from the several Counties of this State, and the City of Baltimore, after the election held lately, for the choice of Electors, on the part of this State, to choose a President and Vice President of the United States, found and, agreeably to the direction of the Act of Assembly, in such case made and provided, to nominate and ascertain the votes given for each person voted for, as aforesaid, and it appearing that William Bent Beale, Joseph Kent, Edward Johnson, John Stephen, John Buchanan, Lawrence Bringle, George Ward, William C. Schiller, Benjamin Mason, Thomas Carroll, and Littleton Dennis Loguen, are duly elected Electors by the part of this State to choose a President and Vice President of the United States.

Therefore it is hereby certified and declared that the said William Bent Beale, Joseph Kent, Edward Johnson, John Stephen, John Buchanan, Lawrence Bringle, George Ward, William C. Schiller, Benjamin Mason, Thomas Carroll, and Littleton Dennis Loguen, are duly elected Electors by the part of this State to choose a President and Vice President of the United States.
