Therefore it is hereby certified and declared that the said William Bent Beale, Joseph Kent, Edward Johnson, John Stephen, John Buchanan, Lawson Brangle, George Warren, William C. Miller, Benjamin C. Masson, Thomas Linnell, and Littleton Lewis Logan, are duly elected Electors on the part of the State, to choose a President and vice President of the United States.
