Proceedings of Electors of President and Vice President of the United States of America in and for the State of Maryland on Monday, December 13, 1948.

Electors of the State of Maryland for President and Vice-President of the United States, assembled in the State House at Annapolis:

There were present: J. Frank Curtis, Samuel A. Schmidt, James W. McAllister Sherman, Flanagan, Augustus L. Knox, Arthur H. Barton; Maurice J. Lusby, Jr.; George C. Warner, Jr.; Sherman Flanagan was selected as Chairman and George C. Warner, Jr., as Vice-Chairman and J. Edgar Harney as Secretary.

The following certificate in duplicate was received from Governor Lom. Preston Lane, Jr.,

I, Lom. Preston Lane, Jr., Governor of the State of Maryland do hereby certify to the Honorable the Secretary of State of the United States, in accordance with the provisions of an act of the Congress of the United States approved June 5, 1934, as follows: The electors of President and Vice President of each State shall meet and give their votes on the first Monday after the second Wednesday in December next following their appointment at such place in each State as the legislature of such State shall direct (48 Stat. 879) that the final ascertainment of the results of the election for Presidential electors of the State of Maryland, held in this State on the 27th day of November, 1948, a copy of which as ascertainment shows that:
