On the First Wednesday in December, the Seventh day of the said Month, in the year, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty six, being the day appointed by the Constitution and Laws of the United States of America, in which the Electors of President and Vice President of the United States of America are directed to assemble and perform the Duty assigned in them, they assembled in the Senate Chamber, in the City of Annapolis, the place provided by Law for the meeting of the said Electors, the following Gentlemen, who had been pre-claimed by the Executive Authority of the State of Maryland, as duly elected Electors of President and Vice President of the United States, in and for the State of Maryland: Towit:
