

LAWS OF MARYLAND.

18. To the St. Mary's Female Orphan Asylum of Baltimore, the sum of five thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of five thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906.

19. To St. Mary's Industrial School, the sum of twenty thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of twenty thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906.

20. To the Baltimore City Hospital, the sum of seven thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of seven thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906; provided the said Baltimore City Hospital shall furnish one bed, maintenance and treatment for one patient at a time from each Senatorial district of the State of Maryland during two years from the date of the passage of this Act.

21. To the Home of the Friendless Children of the Eastern Shore of Maryland, the sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906.

22. To St. Agnes' Hospital, the sum of three thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of three thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906.

23. To the Baltimore Day Nursery, the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1906.

24. To the Baltimore Orphan Asylum, the sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906.

25. To the Maryland Line Confederate Soldiers' Home, at Pikesville, the sum of twelve thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of twelve thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906.

26. To the Board of Trustees of the St. Mary's Female Seminary, the sum of thirty-five hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of thirty-five hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1906; as per Chapter 379 of 1898.

27. To the Country Home for Children of Baltimore City, the sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906.

28. To the Home and Infirmary of Western Maryland, at Cumberland, the sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars for the fiscal year 1906.
