

89. To a legacy of one thousand dollars, under the last will and testament of Martin B. Billingslea, late of Baltimore City, deceased, under the condition and for the purposes set forth in said will, to the trustees of Faith Presbyterian Church, of the City of Baltimore, a body corporate; said will bearing date November 29, 1903, and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills for Baltimore City, in Liber No. 90, folio 30.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same are hereby given, granted and declared to the acquisition by these several religious denominations or sects, orders or corporations hereinbefore in this Act mentioned or named, at any time hereafter, whether by gift, grant or otherwise, of the fee simple title to the lots of land aforementioned, in which they are respectively entitled to leasehold interest or less than a fee simple title, by virtue of several deeds, gifts, grants, bequests or devises aforementioned, and by virtue of the sanction hereinbefore by the first section of this Act given, and to the building, sale, mortgaging, leasing or otherwise disposing of same.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
