

General Laws of this State, be and the same is hereby amended, by adding thereto the following additional section :

SEC. — The Wages or hire of any person or persons, not residing in this State, shall be subject to attachment upon judgment, warrant, or upon two *non-ests*, in the same manner and to no larger extent than the wages or hire of any person or persons, resident in this State. Subject to attachment

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted.* That this act shall take effect from its passage. In force

CHAPTER 231.

AN ACT to regulate the commissions to be allowed clerks of courts for collecting, and paying over to the Treasury public money.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That for receiving and paying over all public money received for licenses, fines or otherwise, the several clerks of courts of this State, shall receive five per centum, except the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas of the City of Baltimore, who shall receive two per centum commissions for receiving and paying over such public money. Commissions of clerks

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act, be and the same are hereby repealed. Repealed

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force
