Resolution in favour of Weber & Co. and A. Schawanecker. Passed April 4, 1836.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore be, and he is hereby directed to pay to Weber & Co., or order, the sum of one hundred and eighty-three dollars and twenty-five cents, and to A. Schawanecker, or order the sum of two hundred and ninety-nine dollars and sixty-eight cents, severally due to each of them for maps furnished for the report of the State Engineer and Geologist.*

## No. 103.

Resolution relative to the repairs of the Public Circle, Passed April 4

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor and Council, be, and they are hereby authorised and directed to cause the wall surrounding the Public Circle to be finished, and to draw upon the Treasurer of the Western Shore, from time to time, for such sum or sums of money as may be necessary for that purpose, not exceeding nine thousand dollars, and the said treasurer is hereby directed to pay the same out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury; Provided, that no part of the money hereby appropriated shall be drawn for until security shall have been given satisfactorily, to the Governor and Council for the completion of the work in the style in which it has been commenced, including gate ways, gates, railing, steps, pavement, gutters and all appurtenances, for a sum not exceeding the said nine thousand dollars.*
