Passed June 3,
1836. Resolution relating to the Eastern Bank of Baltimore.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That instead of nine thousand seven hundred and seventy-five dollars, which by the eleventh section of the act incorporating the Eastern Bank of Baltimore, is required to be paid as a bonus to this State, the said bank shall be required and allowed to pay to this State the sum of nine thousand three hundred and seventy-five dollars.

Passed June 4 Resolution in favor of William B. A. H. Tyler.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William B. A. H. Tyler, the sum of four dollars, for services as extra committee clerk to the House of Delegate, at its present session.

No. 114.

Passed June 4 Resolution in favor of the Governor.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Governor out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury, three hundred dollars, to be applied by him, to the
