*Oden Bowie, Governor of Maryland:*

In conformity to the Constitution and Laws of the State, I respectfully submit the following Report, of the condition of the Treasury, at the close of the fiscal year, ended 30th September last:

**RECEIPTS.**

The total receipts into the Treasury from all sources, during the fiscal year ended 30th September 1870, amounted to \$2,522,478.93, which sum, added to the balance in the Treasury 30th September 1869; viz: \$445,340.41, makes the entire amount in the Treasury for the fiscal year \$2,967,819.34. Statement "A" exhibits fully the sources from which the said amount has been derived.

**DISBURSEMENTS.**

The amount of disbursements during said fiscal year, amounted in the aggregate to \$2,475,069.17, and there remained in the Treasury at the close of the fiscal year, the sum of \$492,750.17. Statement "B" appended to this Report, shows the various purposes for which these disbursements were made, and the Acts of Assembly authorizing the same.

**ESTIMATES.**

Statement "C" exhibits the estimated receipts into the Treasury during the fiscal year ending 30th September 1871, to be \$1,997,300.00.
