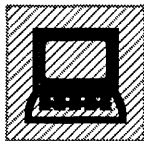
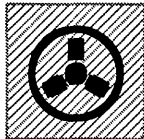
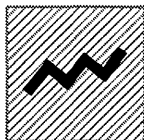


# Forms-by-fax



When it comes to getting copies of tax forms, instructions, helpful brochures and 200 other documents from the State Comptroller's Office, traditional business hours no longer matter.

Taxpayers can have all of those documents faxed to them anytime, 24 hours a day, seven days a week, through the comptroller's Forms-by-Fax service.

By calling from a fax machine or from a touch-tone phone, business and individual taxpayers can follow voice prompts to identify what's available by fax and then place an order of up to five documents at a time.

The popularity of Forms-by-Fax is demonstrated by the 300 incoming calls the service averages each day. Some of the more frequent requests include Maryland's combined registration application for businesses and personal income tax forms for residents and nonresidents.

Since it was introduced in fiscal year 1996, Forms-by-Fax has reduced telephone traffic on taxpayer service lines, manual filling of forms orders and postage costs.
