**30.** Sheriffs shall be entitled to charge and receive the following fees, to wit:

For serving writ and return.....	\$ 60
For taking bail bond.....	50
For collecting officers' fees, for every hundred, six per cent.	
For every commitment and release.....	40
For empaneling a jury.....	3 00
For serving scire facias, including the person summoned, for each person summoned .....	40
For serving citation, for each person summoned.....	60
For executing a warrant of re-survey, per day.....	3 00
For summoning evidences to prove the bounds of land, for each person summoned .....	60
If empowered to swear evidences, for every witness sworn by him..	20
For serving subpoena and return.....	60
For keeping a prisoner in jail and finding him victuals, per day..	30
For serving a writ of possession in ejectment and return.....	3 00
For serving an ejectment and return.....	2 00
For serving an attachment of contempt and return.....	2 00
For serving writ of estrepement or injunction and return.....	2 00
For serving ne exeat and return.....	3 00
For serving a copy of declaration, short note, nar and notice or process .....	20
For summoning appraisers to value goods taken by attachment, fieri facias or replevin, for each appraiser summoned.....	40
For swearing the said appraisers, every oath.....	15
For serving an attachment on judgment or execution or return...	15
For executing a writ of ad quod damnum or melius inquirendum, and return, per day.....	2 50
For empaneling a jury on the same.....	3 00
For swearing the said jury, for every oath.....	20
For taking an inquisition and returning the same with the said writ .....	40
For serving a writ de lunatico inquirendo.....	3 00
For summoning jurors and witnesses therewith, each.....	60
For the inquisition and return therewith.....	3 00
For swearing jurors and witnesses on the same, every oath.....	20
For attendance, per day, after the first day.....	3 00
For summoning jurors and witnesses for law and criminal courts, each .....	60
For serving a writ for re-restitution, and return.....	3 00
For empaneling a jury to inquire of a forcible entry and detainer.	3 00
For every person summoned as an evidence on the same.....	60
For summoning chain carriers, each, if required.....	60
