CHAPTER 316

(House Bill 188)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 46 of Article 77 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Public Education", sub-title "Chapter 4. County Board of Education", making special provision for the annual meeting of the County Board of Education of Montgomery County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 46 of Article 77 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Public Education", sub-title "Chapter 4. County Board of Education", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

46. The County Board of Education shall hold an annual meeting each year on the second Tuesday in May, or as near as possible thereto in May, *except that in Montgomery County such annual meeting shall be held on or before the tenth day of January in each year.* At this meeting the board shall elect one of its members to serve as president and one to serve as vice-president. Other regular meetings shall be held at least once in each school term, and such special meetings may be held as the duties and business of the board may require. The members of the County Boards of Education shall receive no salary, but each member shall receive the sum of One Hundred Dollars annually for traveling and other expenses incident to attending the meetings and transacting the business of the board within the county, provided, however, that in Howard County each member of the Board of Education shall receive annually the sum of Two Hundred Dollars for such traveling and other expenses. In Charles County, each member of the County Board of Education shall receive compensation at
