SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

39K.

(g) The Harford County Liquor Control Board:

(1) May select 1 weekend annually during the months of JUNE, July, August, or September for the wine festival that does not conflict with the Annapolis Wine Festival, the Cumberland and Shenandoah Valley Wine Festival, or the Maryland Wine Festival; and

(2) Shall choose a location in Harford County for this festival which does not hold an alcoholic beverages license.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~October 1~~ June 1, 1992.

**CHAPTER 203**

**(Senate Bill 262)**

AN ACT concerning

**Civil Proceeding – Size of Jury**

FOR the purpose of providing that the parties to any civil proceeding in which the right to a jury trial is preserved are entitled to a trial by jury of at least 6 jurors; providing that the Constitution of Maryland does not prohibit a trial by jury of less than 12 jurors in a civil proceeding in which the right to a jury trial is preserved; and submitting this amendment to the qualified voters of the State of Maryland for their adoption or rejection.
