

MEDICAL AND CHIRURGICAL FACULTY OF MARYLAND.

A FURTHER ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENT to an act entitled an act to establish and incorporate a Medical and Chirurgical Faculty or Society in the State of Maryland

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That from and after the passage of this act, it shall be fully competent for any ten members of the Medical and Chirurgical Faculty of Maryland, who may assemble after a public call published at least twice a week for two weeks in one or more of the daily newspapers of Baltimore city, to transact any or all of the business that may come before said Faculty.

SEC. 2 *And be it enacted,* That so much of charter of said Faculty as calls for fifteen to make a quorum to transact the business of said Faculty, be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after its passage.

MEDICAL AND CHIRURGICAL FACULTY OF MARYLAND.

AN ACT to repeal an act entitled, a further additional supplement to an act entitled an act to establish and incorporate a Medical and Chirurgical Faculty or Society, in the State of Maryland, passed June session eighteen hundred and sixty-one, chapter forty-two, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall be fully competent for any number of the members of the Medical and Chirurgical Faculty of Maryland, not less than five, who may assemble after a public call published at least twice a week, for two weeks, in one or more of the daily newspapers of Baltimore city, to transact any or all of the business that may come before said Faculty.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That so much of the charter of said Faculty as calls for fifteen to make a quorum to transact the business of said Faculty, be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after its passage.
