

January, eighteen hundred and eighty, make a full, clear and explicit statement, giving a full and detailed account of the cost of said court house and jail, and furniture, the name of every person to whom money has been paid in erecting said buildings and supplying furniture for the same, and to publish the said statement for two weeks in the usual way of publishing public matters in Wicomico county.

Publish for two weeks.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That if the County Commissioners shall be unable to meet the payments according to the contract for building said buildings, or either of them, they are hereby authorized, in their discretion, to make a temporary loan of not more than ten thousand dollars, at a rate of interest of not more than six per centum per annum, to be repaid out of the court-house fund as soon as collected.

Make temporary loan.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 198.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Somerset county to levy a sum of money to build a bridge over Morumpsco creek, in said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Somerset county be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to build a bridge across Morumpsco creek of such width as in their discretion may be necessary, and of such height as may be sufficient to allow the passage thereunder of such boats as may navigate the said Morumpsco creek at
