Senate bill, File No. 59, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact sections 33, 211, 212, 213, 214, 215 and 216, of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Allegany County,' sub-title 'County Commissioners and Roads,' and to re-enact the same with amendments, and add certain additional sections to said Article 1, sub-title 'Roads,' and to provide for a road directory and a road engineer in Allegany county and to place all the public roads in said Allegany county under the control of the road directory, to be created by this Act.'"
