2 but defined. I think that possibly did not act as much  
3 as a reversal as a further stimulation of thinking along  
4 the line of what we really meant by a broad grant and  
5 whether or not that was to be of any and all powers  
6 or as defined.

7 That also brings up a third factor which I want  
8 to throw into the picture and be sure that we cover. The  
9 broad grant of power to the home rule unit emanating  
10 from the constitution or a broad grant of power as defined  
11 by the constitution available to the home rule unit, or  
12 a provision in the constitution directing the Legislature  
13 to define. Thus the source being legislative rather than  
14 constitutional. At the last meeting as we were further  
15 considering this matter, the request was made and Dr. Loevy  
16 was requested to make a study of the matter to see what  
17 could be accomplished by way of a broad grant emanating  
18 from the constitution but being defined. Dr. Loevy has  
19 further researched and studied this aspect of the determina-  
20 tion of the division between the local and State units  
21 and has submitted what I want us all to appreciate as being
