No. 3.

Whereas the State of Maryland did, in the year seventeen hundred and ninety, advance the sum of seventy-two thousand dollars (\$72,000) to the use of the General Government, to be applied in such manner as Congress shall direct, towards erecting public buildings; and, whereas, the General Assembly did, on the eleventh day of February, eighteen hundred and forty-three, by resolution, request our then representatives in Congress to obtain the passage of a law refunding said sum, with the interest thereon, to the state; and, whereas, the said sum of money so as aforesaid advanced to the Government.
