

this time, as near as he can ascertain the amount of such receipts within said time, and it shall be the duty of the State Wharfinger hereafter in making his returns to the Comptroller of the State of the receipts from the State wharves in the city of Baltimore, to show distinctly the net receipts from the several Tobacco Warehouse wharves, which several net receipts the Comptroller shall credit to the said Tobacco Fund account, and shall, in his annual report, publish a statement showing the standing of said account with the State.

WHEREAS the heating apparatus of the State House is now placed in the basement of the Comptroller's office; and
