2 of the judges on the panel? Does that cover all the
3 points?

4 DR. BARD: The last sentence, judges shall
5 be removed from office and may include disqualification
6 from holding any office of public trust.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: May I suggest an amendment?
8 Upon conviction, judgment shall be --

9 DR. BARD: Conviction.

10 MRS. BOTHE: I ask the Committee to consider
11 whether there could be some deprivations of office,
12 emoluments and so forth.

13 DR. BARD: Upon conviction, judgment shall
14 be removal from office and may include disqualification
15 from holding any office of public trust.

16 MRS. BOTHE: They are still entitled to more
17 pensions?

18 MR. CLAGETT: As well as deprivation of
19 pension and other emoluments.

20 THE CHAIRMAN: Any objection to adding that
21 phrase?
