Leave granted delegation to report a bill to ratify an ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore appropriating \$500,000, for the use of the city, 10; bill reported, read the first, second and third times by special order, and passed, 13; returned from the Senate passed, 36.

Leave granted Baltimore city delegation to report a bill to add to the 4th article of the Code of Public Local Laws, a section empowering the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to raise and appropriate money for the defense of said city, 10, bill reported, 13; read a first, second and third time by special order, and passed, 13; returned from the Senate passed, 36.

Leave granted delegation to report a bill to amend the fourth article of the Code of Public Local Laws by repealing the 161st, 162nd, 163d, 164th, 165th, 166th, 167th, 168th, 169th, 170th, 172d and 173d sections thereof, 19; reported favorably, and referred to committee on the Judiciary, 19; reported favorably, read a second and, by special order, a third time, and passed, 33; returned from Senate passed amendments which were adopted, 67.
