Hiram Barnes. Printer. Died, January 19, 1797. - Federal Gazette, Jan. 19, 1797.

Matthew Chambers. Apprenticed to Edwards. Absconded, April 20, 1796. - Maryland Journal, May 6, 1796.

Robert Dunsmore. Apprenticed to Edwards. Absconded. "A very good compositor." - Maryland Journal, June 1, 1796.

James Gallaher. Printer. Died, September 25, 1800. - Federal Gazette, Oct. 13, 1800.

Timothy Kuhl. Apprenticed to Bartgis. Public warned against receiving books from Kuhl. - Bartgis's Maryland Gazette, Nov. 21, 1793.

Frazer Richardson. Apprenticed to Edwards. Richardson's character defended by guardian, Philip Hall. - Federal Gazette, Feb. 5, 1796.

James Dudley Roberts. Carrier, employed by Edwards. Absconded, April 16, 1795. - Maryland Journal, Apr. 17, 1795.
