During the course of the fiscal year 1949, there were three changes in the membership of the Hall of Records Commission. Dr. Isaiah Bowman, who had been a member since 1935, when he succeeded Dr. Joseph S. Ames as President of the Johns Hopkins University, retired December 31, 1948.
