An Act to provide for the refunding at a rate of interest not higher than four per centum per annum of certain bonds of Dorchester County, issued in pursuance of the authority contained in Chapter eighty-two of the Acts passed at the January Session, eighteen hundred and ninety-two as amended by Chapter three hundred and forty-three of the Acts passed at the January Session, eighteen hundred and ninety-four, and to authorize the County Commissioners of Dorchester County to borrow money on the credit of said county for the purpose of redeeming said bonds, and to give their bonds or bills obligatory for the payment of the same, and to levy taxes on the assessable property of said county to pay the interest on said bonds or bills obligatory and to redeem the same as they become payable. ....	14
