Chapter 424.

AN ACT to amend article twenty-six of the Public General Laws, title "Corporations," sub-title "Insurance Companies," as amended at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter one hundred and six, and at the January session of eighteen hundred and eighty, chapter three hundred and eighty-seven, and to amend and re-enact section thirty-two of said article as so amended, and to add certain sub-sections, A, B, C, D, E, F, G and H.

Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section thirty-two of article twenty-six of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporations," sub-title "Insurance Companies," as the same was amended by the act of January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter one hundred and six, and at the January session of eighteen hundred and eighty, chapter three hundred and eighty-seven, be and the same is hereby amended and re-enacted, and certain sub-sections, A, B, C, D, E, F, G and H, are hereby enacted so as to read as follows :

License required.

SEC. 32. Any person, body politic or corporate, partnership or association, who or which shall make, negotiate or solicit within this state any contract of insurance, whether of adult or infant, or by whatsoever title the same may be known, or shall effect an insurance or insurances, or pretend to effect an insurance or insurances, or connect any other person or persons with them in any policy they may at the time
