An act to amend the charter of the town of Gaithersburg, in Montgomery county, as said charter was enacted by chapter 397 of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland at the session of 1878; as amended by chapter 320 of the acts of the General Assembly of 1880; by chapter 316 of the General Assembly of 1886; by chapter 541 of the acts of the General Assembly of 1888, and by chapter 237 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1890. . . . . 1225
