

RESOLUTIONS.

1896

No. 7.

A Resolution in favour of Robert Alcock, of Anne-Arundel county, who was a soldier of the revolutionary army. Passed Jan 30, 1896

Resolved, That the treasurer of the western shore pay to Robert Alcock, of Anne-Arundel county, or to his order, during life, in half yearly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private, as a further remuneration for his services during the revolutionary war.

No. 8.

A Resolution in favour of Arthur M'Lean, of Baltimore county, who was a Sergeant in the army of the revolution. Passed Jan 30, 1896

Resolved, That the treasurer of the western shore pay to Arthur M'Lean, of Baltimore county, or to his order, during life, in half yearly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a sergeant, as a further remuneration for his services during the revolutionary war.

No. 9.

A Resolution in favour of George Dent, of Saint-Mary's county, who was a Soldier in the army of the revolution. Passed Jan 30, 1896

Resolved, That the treasurer of the western shore pay to George Dent, of Saint-Mary's county, or to his order, during life, in half yearly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private, as a further remuneration for services during the revolutionary war.

No. 10.

A Resolution requiring the Armourer at Annapolis to deliver to Captain William S. B. Cottman, of Worcester county, certain arms, therein mentioned. Passed Jan 31, 1896

Resolved, That the armourer at Annapolis be and he is hereby required, to deliver to Captain William S. B. Cott-
