No execution to issue for any fine, where the person fined shall give security for the payment thereof and costs, until after the expiration of 60 days, 11 <div style="margin-left: 2em;">Not to issue on a judgment of condemnation in any case of attachment issued on the return of <i>non est</i>, to any city term of Baltimore county court, until six months after the judgment, unless, &amp;c. 161  <div style="margin-left: 2em;">If an editor of a newspaper in any county shall refuse or neglect to publish the notice of any sheriff, &amp;c. for the sale of negroes, lands, &amp;c. such notice may be given by advertisement set up at least 20 days before the sale, at the court house door, and other public places in the county. The sheriff, &amp;c. in his return to the <i>feri facias</i>, &amp;c. shall annex a statement, on oath, of the refusal of the editor, &amp;c. 187</div> </div>
