Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a deed of bargain and sale, executed on the twenty-second day of October, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty-seven, between Margaret Poling, of Randolph county, in the state of Virginia, of the one part, and the aforesaid William Price, of the other part, be, and the same is hereby rendered and made valid, to all intents and purposes, as if the said deed had been recorded within the time limited by law, and as if the said deed had been duly acknowledged by virtue of a power of attorney, in the manner prescribed by law; Frorided accordicless, that nothing in this act contained, shall of erate or be construed to affect, or in any manner interfere, with any right or title, at law or in equity, of, in, or to the property or any part thereof, mentioned in said deed, of any person or persons, acquired subsequent to the date of the execution of said deed, and previous to the recording of the same.

Section 1. Be it mated by the General Assembly of Maryland. That the Commissioners appoined uncer the procusions of the actto which this is a supplement, or a majority of tiens, before they proceed to locate any road proposed to be opened, straightened or shu, up, shall give at least thirty days public adtice, in one or more unvapagers published in the county where such road is, and in all cases where there is no newspaper published in the county, then it shall be the duty of the commissioners to have the notice stuck up at the Court.
