Wherupon the Court being called sat as above proceeded to Business in Manner following - Jofey Dishason, Jofey Dishason an Orphan of his Own free Consent is bound out by the Court to John Richardson here an Apprentice according to Act of Assembly in such Case provided unto John Richardson of Somerset County byer untill he the said Jofey should arrive at the Age of Twenty One years the said Jofey Dishason to serve his said Master the full term of - During which term the said Apprentice his said Master well and faithfully he shall serve his Master keep his Commandments Lawfully and honestly every where willingly he shall doe and in all things as a good and faithfull Apprentice he shall demean himself towards his said Master and all his - During the term of - In Consideration of which Service the said John Dishason present herein - Court in his proper Person Covenanteth with the Justices of the same County Court Judicially sitting in Manner and form following that is to say that he the said John Richardson shall and will during the term of - Learn his said Apprentice the trade of a house Joiner and to Read Write and Cypher as far as the Rule of three Inclusive and at the Expiration of his Servitude Give him a New Suit of - Cloaths of Narrow Broad Cloath Over and above his Common wearing Cloaths and likewise find - and provide for his said Apprentice Meat drink washing Lodging and Cloathing sufficient for such an Apprentice to have and wear during the term of -

Wherupon the said John Richardson doth to Give Security to Comply with the Covenants of - Thereupon the said John Richardson together with Robert Staples and Jacob Thomas of Somerset County Planters his security all present herein Court in their proper persons Acknowledge themselves Indebted unto the said Jofey Dishason in the sum of £100 Money of Maryland on their Oaths Gods or Chables Sides and Tenements faithfully and Severally to the use of the said John Richardson his heirs and Assignes to be made and Paid if it happen that the said John Richardson doth during the term of - Learn his said Apprentice the trade of a house Joiner and to Read Write and Cypher as far as the Rule of three Inclusive and at the Expiration of his Servitude doth Give him a New Suit of - Cloaths of Narrow Broad Cloath Over and above his Common wearing Cloaths and doth likewise find - and provide for his said Apprentice Meat drink washing Lodging and Cloathing sufficient for such an Apprentice to have and wear during the term of -
