

CHAPTER 293.

CHAP. 294.

*An act to authorise the building of a Clerks Office and Register's Office, for Prince George's County, or the enlargement of the present Offices.*

Passed Mar. 22, 1833

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That John Brookes, William D. Bowie, and Benjamin Lee, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners to contract for the building of a clerk's and register's office for Prince George's County: or if they should deem it more expedient, they are hereby authorised to contract for the enlargement of the present offices.

Commissioners to build or enlarge.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Levy Court of Prince George's county, be and they are hereby authorised and directed to levy on the assessable property of said county at such times as they may think proper, such sum or sums of money as the commissioners herein before appointed shall have contracted to pay for the building or enlargement of the aforesaid offices.

CHAPTER 294.

*An act for the relief of Benjamin Buck, of the City of Baltimore.*

Passed Mar. 22, 1833

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the commissioners of insolvent debtors for the city and county of Baltimore, be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered, to grant to Benjamin Buck, of the city of Baltimore, the benefit of the several acts of Assembly, passed for the relief of insolvent debtors; *Provided*, the said Benjamin Buck shall, in all respects, (except that of proving residence,) comply with the requisitions of said acts of Assembly, and that he satisfy the said commissioners that he did not come into this State with the view of obtaining the benefit of the said insolvent laws.
