

## CHAPTER 309.

CHAP. 31 1

*An act supplemental to an act, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-two, entitled, an act to repeal an act, entitled, an act to abolish Imprisonment for Debt on certain judgments rendered by Justices of the Peace, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty, chapter one hundred and fifty-five.* Passed Mar 23, 1833

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Construction given.  
That nothing contained in the act, to which this is a supplement, shall be construed to extend to judgments obtained before the twentieth day of March, eighteen hundred and thirty-three.

## CHAPTER 310.

*An act for the Payment of the Journal of Accounts.* Passed Mar. 23, 1833

WHEREAS, it appears by the Journal of Accounts of this session, that there is due from this State, the sum of forty-three thousand three hundred and twenty-four dollars and eighty-one and one-fourth cents, current money, Therefore, Preamble.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Payment directed  
That the Treasurer of the Western Shore be, and he is hereby authorised and required, to pay to the several persons, their executors, administrators, assigns or orders, or to such of them as shall offer to receive the same, the several sums of money allowed to them respectively, as they appear to be settled and ascertained by the said journal of accounts, out of any money now in the treasury, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly.

*An act to divorce Ann Tompkins and William Tompkins.* Passed Mar. 23, 1833

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Divorce granted.
