His Lordship of Kent County ss. The Jurors for the Right Honourable the Lord Prop. of that now is for the body of Kent County Isaac Ashley - and upon their Oath do present that Isaac Ashley late of St. Pauls parish in the County of Labourer the first Day of May Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and twenty four with force and Arms at the parish and in the County and within the Jurisdiction of this Court and within of the price of ten Shillings Current money of Maryland of the Goods and Chattels of a certain Honour Hurley Men and there being found that he feloniously did steal take Drive and Load away contrary to the force of the said Lord Prop. of that now is his good Rule and Government and against the form of the Act of Assembly in such Cases made and provided Vc.
