tion and good Behaviour and that the Sheriff of Trent County keep him  
the s<sup>d</sup> Charles Meale in safe Custody until he shall Enter as afo<sup>re</sup> —  
Thereupon Charles Meale of Trent County Planter present here in Court in  
his proper person doth Acknowledge himself Indebted unto the Right &  
Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> of this Province of Maryland in the Sum of ten  
pounds Sterl to be Levied of his Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements  
for y<sup>e</sup> use of the s<sup>d</sup> Lord prop<sup>r</sup> by his heirs or Conditionally that if he shall  
not make his personal appearance <sup>here</sup> at any time During this Court Sitting  
to answer unto an Information for fornication and if that in the mean  
time the s<sup>d</sup> Charles shall not be of good Behaviour where with y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Court  
is Content. also

Francis Reed and W<sup>m</sup> Dicus both of Trent County Planters present here in  
Court in their proper persons do Acknowledge themselves Indebted unto the  
Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> of this Province of Maryland in the Sum  
of five pounds Sterl each to be Levied of their goods and Chattels Lands  
and Tenements for y<sup>e</sup> use of y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Lord prop<sup>r</sup> by his heirs or Conditionally  
that if y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Charles Meale shall not make his personal appearance here  
at any time During this Court Sitting to answer unto an Information for  
Fornication and if that in the mean time the s<sup>d</sup> Charles shall not be of good  
Behaviour where with y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Fra<sup>s</sup> Reed and W<sup>m</sup> Dicus are Content —

The s<sup>d</sup> Charles Meale having Entered into recogn<sup>o</sup> for his appearance at any time  
during this Court Sitting to answer unto an Information for fornication and  
good Behaviour and now at this Day y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Court appearing ordered that his  
Recognizance and his Sheriff's recogn<sup>o</sup> be Discharged —

Charles Meale of Trent County Planter at this Court doth Acknowledge  
himself Indebted unto the Lord prop<sup>r</sup> of this Province in the Sum of  
ten pounds Sterl to be Levied of his Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements  
unconditionally that if he should not  
make his personal appearance here at any time During Court Sitting  
to answer unto an Information for fornication and in the meantime
