 ally that if the said Charles Smith shall not make his personal  
 appearance at the next Court to be hold for Queen Anns County the  
 fourth Tuesday of this Instant November to Answer unto what shall  
 be objected against him at the Same Court on behalf of his Lordship  
 and that he the said Charles Smith is not to Depart the Same Court without  
 leave and that in the mean time he is not to be of Good Behaviour  
 wherewith they Acknowledge themselves Content
