Test Alice Brown

And the said William Coursey in his proper person comes and saith that he cannot gain say the Information aforesaid against him brought nor can he say but that he is guilty of y^e premises above upon him imposed as by the said Information it is alleged and thereupon submits to y^e Court. Therefore it is Considered by the Justices here below at the Court house in the Town of Annapolis in Front County this twentyeth Day of June Anno Domini 1727 that the said William Coursey pay the sume of thirty shillings Current money of Maryland as a fine for his aforesaid offence of committing fornication in form aforesaid. Also it is Considered that he pay the sume of three hundred and forty five pounds of Tobacco Cobs accruing on the premises aforesaid to the officers of this Court

James Smith

Ordered by the Court here that y^e said William Coursey enter into Recognizance with good Security for to keep the County of Front County from all Charges that may accrue by Occasion of the said Alice Brown Child

Thereupon William Coursey and George Wilson both of this County acknowledge themselves Indebted in the sume of five thousand pounds of Tobacco Conditionally that if the said William Coursey shall not keep the County free from all Charges that may accrue by Occasion of the said Alice Brown Child where with they are both Content

Alice Brown having entered into Recognizance at last Court for her appearance at this Court as an Evidence for his Lordship against the said W^m Coursey and now at this Court y^e said Alice appearing ordered that her Recognizance and her Surety thereof be discharged

Alice Brown of Front County Spinster at last Court as aforesaid acknowledged herself Indebted unto y^e Lord prop^y of this province of Maryland in the sume of five pounds Sterling to be levied of her goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements Conditionally that if she should not make her personal appearance before the Justices of this Court as aforesaid for his Lordship against the said W^m Coursey and now at this Court on the 20th Day of June Anno Domini 1727 y^e said Alice having appeared her Recognizance is discharged

Robert Brown of Front County planter at last Court as aforesaid acknowledged himself Indebted unto the Lord prop^y of this province of Maryland in the
