 Great Britain to be made and Levied of his goods and Chattels
 Lands and Tenements for the use of his said Lordship his heirs
 and Successors Conditionally that if he should not make
 his personall appearance at the then next November Court
 to answer unto what should be objected against him on his
 Lordships behalf and that in the mean time he be of good behav.

And now at this Court here to wit the twenty first Day of
 November the time to which he was bound Anno Dom 1727
 hundred twenty and seven the said William having appeared his
 Recognizance is discharged —
