

J. H. Lord Muste } This Court here orders that the atty of the Lord  
 Samuel Cooke } property of this Court Exhibit an Information against  
 the sd Samuel. which is accordingly done and is  
 as followeth

It is shewn by the Memorandum that Joseph Francis Gent. atty  
 of the right Honourable the Lord property that now is for the County of who for the  
 same Lord property in this part prosecuted doth come hereto the said County Court be-  
 fore William Brisby Esq. and his Associates his Lordships Justice of the same  
 County Court to wit at the Town in the sd County the day of August  
 Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty and for the same Lord property doth  
 give the Court here to understand and be informed that Samuel Cooke of St. Pauls  
 Parish in the County of Taylor the tenth day of July Anno Domini Seventeen  
 hundred and thirty at the Parish of in the County of within the Jurisdiction of  
 this Court in and upon John Bath in the peace of God and the said Lord property then  
 and there being with force and Arms an assault did make and to the said John  
 then and there did beat wound and evilly treat so that his life it was endangered and  
 other harms to him did to the great Damage of the said John and contrary to the  
 peace of the same Lord property his good rule and Government &c. wherefore  
 the sd attorney prayeth the advice of the Court here in the premises for the said  
 Lord property and due process of Law against the sd Samuel in this part to issue  
 to answer to the said Lord property of and upon the premises &c.

The return the Court ordered that Capias Issues against the sd Sam<sup>e</sup>  
 upon the Information &c.

But now here came the sd Samuel Cooke and saith that he cannot answer  
 the Information &c. So a safe against him brought nor but that he is guilty of  
 the premises &c. above upon him imposed as by the sd Information it is alleged  
 and thereupon Submits to the Court. Therefore it is Considered by the  
 Court here to wit that the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the  
 third day of August being the eighteenth day of said Month Anno Domini Seventeen  
 hundred and thirty that the sd Samuel Cooke pay the sum of one hundred  
 pounds of Tobacco as a fine to the right Honourable the Lord property for committing  
 of the assault &c. as aforesaid and also pay the sum of two hundred fifty  
 pounds of Tobacco as a fine accruing on the premises &c. to the officers of this  
 Court

ordered by the Court here that Joseph Young Gent. Sheriff of the said County  
 keep the sd Samuel Cooke in safe Custody until the fine and fees &c. shall be  
 satisfied. The return came into Court

Mr. Charles Hymsen of said County and saith that he will pay the fine  
 and fees &c. to whom they belong. and the said Samuel is discharged

Whereas the sd Samuel on the seventeenth day of July last entered  
 into Recognizance before the sd Charles Hymsen Gent. one of the Lordships  
 Justice of the peace for the sd County for his appearance to this Court  
 &c. and the sd Samuel in his proper person comes and appears  
 to the sd Recognizance &c. ordered by the Court here that the same
