the afo Roger on Suspicion of felony then the above Recognizance to be void  
Else to remain in force

And now here at this Court to wit at the Court house in the Town of Chester in  
said County on the third Wednesday in June in the afo being the fifteenth day of said  
Month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty one came the afo Roger Fuzzing  
and appeared ordered by the Court here that the afo Recognizance be deful

Thereupon the same Recognizance is by this Court deful who was taken for

Coath out of the Custody of the afo John being the Goods and Chattels of a certain  
Thomas Anis then the above Recognizance to be void Else to remain in force
