Daniel Flinn Junr at last March Court entered into recognizance in the sum of five pounds Sterl with Bowles Guoon his Surety in the same sum as for the sum Daniels app. to this Court as an evid in the afo case And now here at this Court to wit the third Tuesday in June being the twelfth day of said month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty two came the afo Daniel and in his proper person appeared and prayed that his recognizance and Surety might be discharged. ORDERED by the same Court that the same recognizance be disp'd as prayd This Court here discharges the same Daniel Flinn Junr his recognizance as also Bowles Guoon's recognizance as afo they are here each disp'd

Daniel Flinn Junr comes into Court and being sworn swears that he attended in the afo case as his Lordship against the afo Elizabeth Flinn and Margerol his wife as an evidence fourteen days.
