and the said Margaret Wood in her proper person cometh and saith that she is in no sort guilty of the premises above upon her imposed as by the said Indictment it is alledged and thereof she putteth her self upon the Country

ALLD now who followeth for the Lord property in like manner saith she is guilty

Whereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of that County that he immediately by cause to come here to wit the day and Year last mentioned came again the said Lord property by his attorney Atty and the said Margaret Wood in her proper person and the Jurors of that Jury being impanelled and called likewise came to wit John Dorrell Samuel Morris Lukner Middleton John James William Hyson Robert Mosher John Carvill Thomas Prior Bulmer Modford William Smithers William Moore and George Modford who being duly elected tryd and sworn to say the truth the premises upon their oath today Margaret Wood is guilty of the felony whereof she stands indicted and by John Dorrell the foreman all so say. . . Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit at that County Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in November being the twenty first day of said Month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty two that the said Margaret Wood stand in the pillory for the space of one hour and that afterwards she receive at the public whipping post fifteen lashes well laid on her bare back till the blood appear and also pay the four fold of the Goods of amounting in value to the sum of two hundred pounds of Tobacco as a punishment for committing the same and according to force form and effect of the Ordinance of the Jurors and ALSO it is considered that
