 True bill by Robert Dunn foreman
 and at the County to wit at the Court House in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in March being the annoteenth day of said Month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty three came the afd widow
 By her atty afd. and the afd Judgment was continued until the third
 Tuesday in June then next ensuing

At which said third Tuesday in June being the eighteenth day of
 said Month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty
 four came the afd her Lordship by her atty afd and the afd Elizabeth Macfield
 in her proper person and prayed the same cause might be continued until
 the then next Court being the third Tuesday in August

At which said third Tuesday in August being the twentieth day of said
 Month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty four came against
 the afd her Lordship by her said attorney and the afd Mary Macfield
 in her proper person comes and saith that she cannot give any the
 afd Judgment so as afd against her brought nor can she say but that
 she is guilty as above said as by the afd Judgment it is alleged
 and thereupon submits to the Court — Therefore it is considered
 by the Justices here to wit the same day and year last mentioned that
 the afd Elizabeth Macfield do find the sum of thirty Shilling Curr.
 money as a fine for committing the fornication afd in form afd
 Confest and the sum of four hundred and eleven — pounds of
 Tobacco cost accruing on the premises afd to the officers of this
 Court

Ordered by this Court that the same Elizabeth Macfield be committed
 into the custody of John Presham Sher of Kent County and that the
 same Sheriff keep the same Elizabeth in safe custody until the afd
 afd be paid

After which came Thomas agree of Kent County Pleader and
 in his proper person Acknowledged himself indebted to the right
 honorable the Lord prople in the sum of eight hundred pounds
 of Tobacco Land usually that if he do not pay the fees accruing on
 the premises afd to the officers of this Court
