John Underhill jun. & Ishmale Bennett as prosecut. in the Sum of twenty per

At the same time before the same Justice a certain David Griffith an
an Ind. held into Recognizance in the Sum of ten per Stord for ap. to this
Court the sd. Edward in his proper person ap. ordered by the same
Court that the same be discharged the same is by this Court defid.
As also Ishmale Bennett who was Surety for the sd. Edward under Recogn.
for the Sum of ten per Stord for his ap. to this Court the same is also
defid.

Ordered by the Court here that the said John as there is an
Indictm. felony ag. him in this Court and now in his proper person
ap. to be kept and pleaded not guilty - It is thereupon ord. that he
give Security for his ap. to next Court &c. On which the same John
Underhill Jun. of Kent County Planter here in Court with and Acknowledg.
himself indebted to the Right Honorable the Lord Proprietor in the Sum of twenty
pounds Stord to be levied on his goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements
Conditionally that to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors -
Conditionally that if he doth not appear at the next Court to be held for
Said County on the third Tuesday in March next to answer unto a certain
Indictment of felony for Stealing Wheat the goods and Chattels of a certain
Ishmale Bennett and in the meantime he is to be of good behav.
As hereunto he Acknowledg. himself to be content
At the same Court came William Elms of the same County Planter
and Acknowledg. himself indebted to the Right Honorable the Lord Proprietor
