 Heire and Successors Conditionally That of his said Patrick Garwick Shall not make his personal
 appearance at the next Court to be held at our Court House in the Towne of Chester in said County
 on the third Tuesday in March next to answere unto the afoide Indictment of felony and that in the
 mean time he is to be of good behav. wherew^t he Acknowledges himselfe Contented

But afterwards at the same Court the same day came the afoide Securites and
 saith that they are affraid of afoide Patrick will not stay to the next County Court and abide his trial
 : all wherefore praye of us that will take the same Patrick and discharge him Thereupon the
 said Patrick being present in Court in his proper person and appears and prayes that for as much as his
 Sureties are not willing to stand for him that the Court will discharge w^tth recognizance.
 Thereupon the Court Orders that the same be discharged and was done at the same Court in
 the same Patrick's recognizance And the said Master Marys John Beck and William Beck there
 were no recognizances for him the said Patrick were all discharged

ordered by this Court here That the said Patrick Garwick be kept in safe custody by the Sheriff
 of said County until he shall give security for his appearance to next Court to Anno. unto the afoide
 Indictment and that in the mean time he is to be of good behav.

Shew^t The afoide Indictment that he hath no security laid for his app^r to
 next Court and Thereupon prays a royal Indemnity to such Person^s as
 of the City of this Court prosecute the same Indictment ag^t the afoide Patrick And Thereupon it is Ord^red
 that Joseph Young Gent Sherrif of said County be present in Court to keep the afoide Patrick in safe custody
 until he shall have his trial on the same Indictment. But afterwards the same Patrick comes before
 Court that he hath Security to go to Anno. as above And Thereupon comes into Court and Acknow-
 ledges himselfe Indebted to the Right Hon^rble the Lord Proprietary in the sum of Sixty pounds Sterling
